Terms and Conditions

This agreement is between 'you' (the student or parent/guardian) and 'us/we' (SCIMS Academy).

- 3. Any change in your contact details must be intimated immediately.
- 4. We do not guarantee your success in JEE-Main / JEE-Advanced / XII boards / other competitive exams, in spite of providing the best training; due to high competition, limited number of seats, and dependence on other factors (like your effort, aptitude etc.).
- 5. We expect our server to be accessible most of the time, except for maintenance activities that may be unplanned; if we think there is a problem that needs immediate attention.
- 6. You must provide us with your registration no. for Class XII board, JEE or other competitive exams, whenever we ask for it, or it is available with you.
- 7. If you succeed in any competitive exam(s), please let us know how our course has helped you. We may also request you for a short letter of appreciation and latest photograph, to help us promote our course.
- 8. We may request occasional feedback on the quality of our course, and we expect you to give honest feedback. Your feedback will help us maintain and improve the course for future students.
